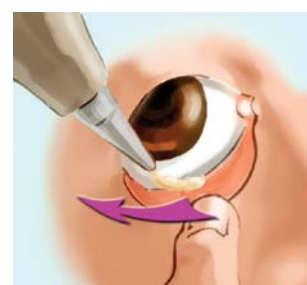


Instructions for Using Eye Drops or Eye Ointment

1. Wash your hands before applying eye medications.
2. Tilt your head backwards when applying eye medications.
3. Pull the lower eyelid down gently and look upwards:
Eye drops - instill 1-2 drops into the lower and medial fornix. (Fig. 1)
Ointment - squeeze 2-3mm and apply it into the lower fornix. (Fig. 2)
4. Close the eyes and use clean facial tissue to wipe off any excess medications, and then press the inner canthus gently with your index finger tip for about 1 minute.
5. Do not touch the eye with the tip of the container when using eye medications.
6. Wait for 3-5 minutes between each medication.
7. Always apply eye drops before eye ointment if you need to use them both.
8. Vision will be blurred temporarily after eye ointment is instilled.
9. Always keep the container tightly closed in a cool place after each application. Avoid direct sunlight.
10. Follow doctor's instructions to use the eye medications.
